Master Site Plan



Phase 1: UHS Parcel

Construction complete

Phase 2: York Region Parcel

 Building interior works are underway and exterior hardscape works have begun

Phase 3: Minto Parcel

- 1st SPA submission made in May 2022; addressing City comments and making 2nd submission in November
- ZBA approved for 34/36/38 Eureka Street; Committee of Adjustment meeting on November 9th for severances at 36 and 38 Eureka



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE





- Front driveway and walkway interlock and first coat of asphalt is complete
- Trees and shrubbery have been planted
- Parking garage traffic coating complete
- One elevator is in operation and the hoistway was removed
- Juliet balconies have been installed and final windows are being installed where hoistway was
- Electrical, plumbing, HVAC and drywall installation completed in suites up to the 7th floor.
- Suite finishes has started on floors 2 to 4.
- Cabinetry installation for 2nd floor to be completed next month






Site Plan Highlights

- 1st Site Plan Submission made in May 2022 consisting of 119 units (38 Back-to-Back Townhomes & 81 Traditional Townhomes)
- Currently addressing City comments with intent of making a second submission in November 2022
- Land Titles Absolute: Letter to be sent to residents who provided objections

- Minto has coordinated with the landowners of 34, 36 and 38 Eureka Street to acquire the lands shown on the image in order to provide a municipal park to the City of Markham as part of Minto's development
- Zoning By-Law Amendment Application (R3 to OS1) for 34/36/38 Eureka St was approved following Markham's DSC Public Meeting on September 6th.
- Committee of Adjustment meeting for rear yard severance at 36 and 38 Eureka Street set for Nov 9th

STARTING DATE: SUMMER 2022

EXPECTED DURATION OF PHASE: APPROXIMATELY FOUR MONTHS (SEPTEMBER 2022)

The Regional Municipality of York is pleased to provide this update on construction activity for the new affordable housing building for seniors in your community.

Housing York Inc., York Region's non-profit housing provider, is committed to being a good neighbour throughout the construction process and beyond. We continue to work closely with our construction partner Martinway Caratzachia, and the City of Markham to ensure that a comprehensive construction management plan is followed.

The health and safety of construction workers and you – our neighbours – is our top priority.

As with any construction project, you may experience some inconveniences around the site. Martinway will make every effort to minimize disruptions when possible. We appreciate your support and understanding as we bring modern affordable housing for seniors into the community.



What to expect during this phase of construction:

- Construction of 12th floor is complete and final window installation is being done
- The grey exterior cladding (pre-cast panels) has been stained to the city-approved colour scheme
- Once the building is fully enclosed, work will continue on the interior
- Plumbing, framing and drywall work is in progress and will continue throughout the summer
- Installation of electrical rough-ins (wiring) and HVAC (heating, ventilation and air conditioning) is underway
- Short traffic disruptions may occur occasionally as materials and machinery are transported to and from the site
- Landscaping work has started and will continue over the summer months
- Landscaping work may cause periods of intreased noise, dust, vibration and traffic/ truck activity
