



- Eight new transitional units at Sutton Youth Services, including 1- and 2-bedroom units
- The new homes will provide young people a safe and stable place to live
- Each home will have its own private kitchen and washroom as well as front and back porches
- Residents can still access supports and services in the Sutton Youth Services building
- The new homes will be built by December 31, 2021

Fall 2021



September – December

- Install decks
- **Exterior Landscaping**



- Install plumbing and electrical systems
- Install HVAC system



- Interior painting and clean-up
- Install furniture


