

Resources for Inclusion Support in Early Learning Settings (R.I.S.E.)

How R.I.S.E. will support early learning and child care programs in York Region

The York Region Children's Services Resources for Inclusion Support in Early Learning Settings (R.I.S.E.) program provides wraparound supports and services to early learning and child care settings to enhance inclusive practices for the active and meaningful participation of all children.

The goal is to provide ongoing training and resources to early learning and child care professionals to build confidence as they support inclusive classrooms.

These supports include:

- The Capacity Building Support Identification Tool (CBSIT)
- Building a classroom plan
- Classroom consultations
- Positive Early Childhood Education Program (PECE) coaching
- Classroom resources, such as visual aids and links to information on classroom adaptations and learning videos
- Capacity building workshops
- Community resources and referrals to community providers of services and supports, such as children's mental health agencies
- Other funded classroom supports, such as, PECE online modules, funded training and classroom assistants
