<b>Subject</b>	<b>2006 Subsidy Levels</b>
<b>Authority</b>	Operating Agreement
<b>Summary</b>	Municipal Non-Profit program housing providers are required to submit annual budgets.
<b>Background</b>	Operating subsidies are determined by applying inflation and rent factors to the prior year budget.
<b>Procedure</b>	The Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing has set the 2005 factors as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cost Factor: 3.15%</li><li>• Rent Inflation Factor: 2.1%</li></ul>
<b>Action Required</b>	Municipal Non-Profit housing providers are required to submit their 2006 budgets to the Region, 90 days before the start of their fiscal year.
