


Notice of Public Information Meeting to Discuss York Region's Approach for Sewage Servicing through Lake Simcoe Innovative Wastewater Treatment Technologies



The Regional Municipality of York invites you to attend a Public Information Meeting on November 16 to discuss how York Region is planning to manage wastewater from approved growth in Aurora, East Gwillimbury, and Newmarket.

The preferred alternative includes an innovative Water Reclamation Centre located in East Gwillimbury to treat wastewater for discharge to the Lake Simcoe watershed using environmentally sustainable wastewater purification and water recycling technologies, and modifications to the existing York Durham Sewage System in Aurora and Newmarket.

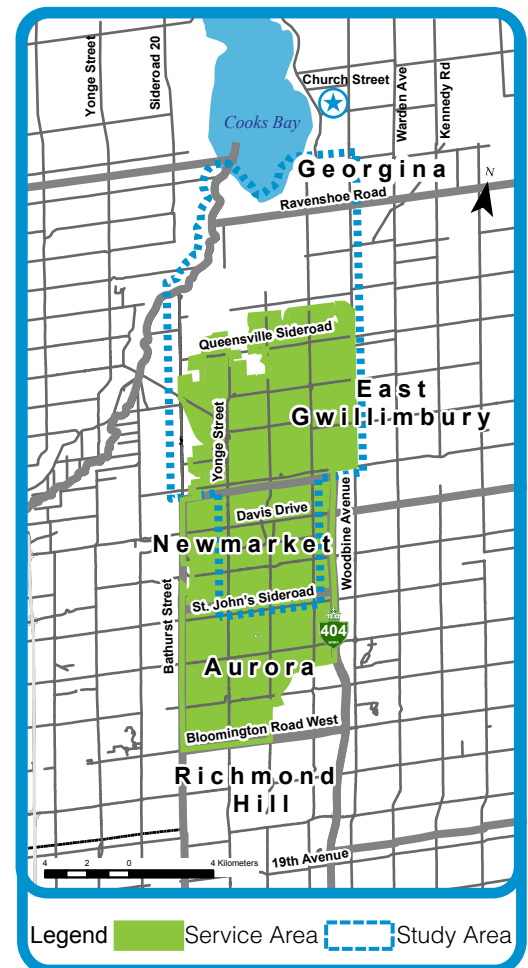
