

Homemakers and Nurses Services program

York Region has contracts with healthcare agencies who provide homemaking and nurses services. York Region provides subsidies for eligible residents.

The agencies provide in-home services to assist York Region residents requiring support to remain in their home environment.

Services may include light housekeeping such as vacuuming, dusting and laundry, as well as meal preparation.

Homemaking and nursing services are available throughout York Region.

Who is eligible for the Homemakers and Nurses Services Program?

To be eligible for the program you must:

- ✓ be a resident of York Region
- ✓ be financially eligible for the program
- ✓ require the services of a homemaker or nurse because you are ill, convalescent, elderly, or a person with a disability

How do I apply to the Homemakers and Nurses Services Program?

There are three ways to apply to the program:

1. through a referral from the Community Care Access Centre (CCAC)
2. through your physician
3. By calling **1-888-256-1112**, or **TTY: 905-762-0401**, and applying for homemaking and nursing services.

What is involved in the application process?

A worker from the Community Services and Housing Department will visit you in your home to complete a detailed review of your financial status. This will include reporting of your assets, income and expenses and those of your spouse and dependents, if applicable.

Support available through family members and/or other community agencies will also be considered in assessing your need for the services of a homemaker or nurse.
