## **POLICY REPORTS**

### **REPORTS SUBMITTED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION AND WORKS**

**8. Environmental Assessment Study Highway 404 Mid-Block Crossover 25**

April 30, 2003, recommending that:

1. Regional staff be authorized to undertake an Environmental Assessment (EA) study for the mid-block crossing of Highway 404 between Highway 7 and Sixteenth Avenue, subject to one third funding from each of the Towns of Richmond Hill and Markham.
2. The Region agree to funding one third of the cost of the study, at an estimated cost of \$50,000 to the Region, from development charges.
3. Copies of this report be sent by the Regional Clerk to the Clerks of Richmond Hill and Markham, to the Clerks of the other local municipalities for information and to the Ministry of Transportation.

**9. Cost Sharing for Road Improvements Major Mackenzie Drive at McNaughton Road 55**

April 30, 2003, recommending that:

1. Regional Council approve the expenditure of approximately \$900,000.00, or one third of the total cost (approximately \$2,700,000) for the cost-sharing, with the City of Vaughan and York Major Holdings Inc. (YMH), for roadwork on Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25) at the new proposed location for McNaughton Road.
2. The Commissioner of Transportation and Works be authorized to disburse funds from the 2003 Roads Capital Budget.
3. The Regional solicitor be authorized to develop an agreement to establish the method of payment and to facilitate the construction of the Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25) road works with the reconstruction of McNaughton Road between Keele Street (Y.R. 6) and Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25) and the Regional watermain on McNaughton Road and Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25).

4. The construction of the Regional road works be administered by YMH subject to a public tender call in conformance with the general requirements of the Regional Purchasing By-law.
5. The Regional Clerk forward a copy of this report to the City of Vaughan.

**10. Encroachment Agreement 67  
Electronic Bulletin Board Sign  
Chabad Lubavitch  
City of Vaughan**

April 23, 2003, recommending that:

1. The Transportation and Works Committee provide direction on the request from Chabad Lubavitch for the placement of an electronic bulletin board sign at the corner of Bathurst Street (Y.R. 38) and Chabad Gate.

**11. Consultant Selection for Engineering Services 73  
West Rainbow Creek Trunk Sewer  
City of Vaughan Project No. 77310**

April 24, 2003, recommending that:

1. The consulting engineering firm of Totten Sims Hubicki Associates be engaged to undertake the Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA), detailed design and contract administration including full-time site supervision for the West Rainbow Creek Trunk Sewer as outlined in this report, at an upset limit cost of \$212,902.00 , including GST.

**12. Consultant Selection for Engineering Services 79  
Pine Valley Relief Sewer  
City of Vaughan, Project No. 77340**

April 24, 2003, recommending that:

1. The consulting engineering firm of Ainley Group be engaged to undertake the Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA), detailed design and contract administration including full-time site supervision for the Pine Valley Relief Sewer as outlined in this report, at an upset limit cost of \$354,462.11, including GST.

**13. Temporary Road Closure of St. John's Sideroad  
Between Bathurst Street and Yonge Street  
Town of Aurora 85**

April 23, 2003, recommending that:

1. Regional Council authorize the temporary closure of St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26) between Bathurst Street (Y.R. 38) and Yonge Street (Y.R. 1), from Monday, June 9, 2003 to Saturday, July 5, 2003 for the reconstruction of St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26).
2. The Regional Solicitor prepare the necessary by-law.
3. Copies of this report be forwarded by the Regional Clerk to the Clerk of the Town of Aurora, and to Ballymore Development (Aurora) Corp.

**14. Temporary Road Closures 91  
Leslie Street, Warden Avenue, Old Homestead Road,  
Vivian Road, Park Road and Pefferlaw Road  
Railway Crossing Maintenance**

*April 23, 2003, recommending that:*

1. *The Commissioner of Transportation and Works be authorized to exercise any of the powers of Regional Council for the temporary closures to through traffic at the Canadian National Railway (CNR) crossings, for a period of one day for each crossing, at a time to be determined in discussions between the Region's Transportation and Works staff and CNR officials on the following roads:*
  - *Leslie Street (Y.R. 12) south of Stouffville Road (Y.R. 14).*
  - *Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) south of St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26).*
  - *Old Homestead Road (Y.R. 79) east of Weir's Sideroad.*
  - *Vivian Road (Y.R. 74) east of Kennedy Road (Y.R. 3).*
  - *Park Road (Y.R. 18) north of Ravenshoe Road (Y.R. 32).*
  - *Pefferlaw Road (Y.R. 21) in Pefferlaw.*
2. *The Regional Solicitor be authorized to prepare the necessary by-laws to give effect to the foregoing.*

**15. Temporary Speed Zones  
2003 Construction Project**

**93**

April 23, 2003, recommending that:

1. Temporary 60-km per hour speed zones be adopted on the following roadways with the implementation occurring between June 1, 2003 and December 31, 2004, and only as necessary during the actual construction activities:
  - a) Lloydtown Aurora Road (Y.R. 16), from 500 metres east of Weston Road (Y.R. 56) to 800 metres west of Weston Road (Y.R. 56), in the Township of King.
  - b) Weston Road (Y.R. 56), from 500 metres south of Lloydtown Aurora Road (Y.R. 16) to 500 metres north of Lloydtown Aurora Road (Y.R. 16), in the Township of King.
  - c) Major Mackenzie Drive East (Y.R. 25), from Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65) to approximately one kilometre east of Warden Avenue (Y.R. 65), in the Town of Markham.
  - d) Elgin Mills Road (Y.R. 49), from Bayview Avenue (Y.R. 34) to Woodbine Avenue (Y.R. 8), in the Towns of Richmond Hill and Markham.
2. Temporary 50-km per hour speed zones be adopted on the following roadways with the implementation occurring between June 1, 2003 and December 31, 2003, and only as necessary during the actual construction activities:
  - a) Rutherford Road (Y.R. 73), from Weston Road (Y.R. 56) to Napa Valley Drive, in the City of Vaughan.
  - b) Bayview Avenue (Y.R. 34), from Wellington Street (Y.R. 15) to St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26), in the Town of Aurora.
  - c) St. John's Sideroad (Y.R. 26), from Yonge Street (Y.R. 1) to Bayview Avenue (Y.R. 34), in the Town of Aurora.
3. The Regional Solicitor prepare the necessary by-laws.

4. A copy of this report be forwarded by the Regional Clerk to the Clerks of the Township of King, City of Vaughan, the Towns of Aurora, Markham and Richmond Hill, and the Chief of Police.
5. York Regional Police be requested to assist in the enforcement of these temporary speed zones, as their resources permit.

  - a) The land required for the widening and reconstruction of Rutherford Road (Y.R. 73) from Weston Road (Y.R. 56) to Highway 50, (Y.R. 24), in the City of Vaughan.

**18. Compensation for Expropriation 117**  
**Intersection Queensville Sideroad and Second Concession Road**  
**Project 9066, Town of East Gwillimbury**

April 29, 2003, recommending that:

1. The Commissioner of Finance be authorized to make the following offer on behalf of the Regional Corporation in accordance with the *Expropriations Act* for:
  - a) The land required for the reconstruction of turning lanes at the intersection of Queensville Sideroad (Y.R. 77) and Second Concession Road in the Town of East Gwillimbury.

**19. Compensation for Expropriation 121**  
**Ninth Line Sewer and Road Widening, Project 7805**  
**Town of Markham**

April 29, 2003, recommending that:

1. The Commissioner of Finance be authorized to make the following offers on behalf of the Regional Corporation in accordance with the *Expropriations Act* for:
  - a) The land required for the construction of the Ninth Line Trunk Sewer and the widening and reconstruction of the Ninth Line (YR 69) in the Towns of Whitchurch-Stouffville and Markham.
