**Subject** Senior Citizens Government Pension Income

**Summary** For the period April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2002 to June 30, 2002, the guaranteed income levels will *remain the same as the previous two quarters.*

**Background** The Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario Senior Citizens represents the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens.

GAINS Rate Tables are sent out quarterly from the Ministry of Finance.

**Update** The guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens for the period of April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2002 to June 30, 2002 are as follows:
