## Human service providers to commemorate progress of ethno-cultural inclusivity actions

*HSPC's Inclusivity Action Plan celebrates a Year in Review*

**NEWMARKET** – The Human Services Planning Coalition (HSPC) will showcase the progress made over the last year by six working groups involving 88 participants from 47 human service organizations, in making York Region a more ethno-culturally inclusive community.

Billed as “A Year in Review,” the event on Thursday will be hosted by the Steering Committee of the York Region Inclusivity Action Plan, an initiative of the HSPC.

The morning will begin with a short drama entitled *The Faces of Freedom*, performed by students attending Richmond Green Secondary School in the Town of Richmond Hill. In addition, York Region staff will present highlights from *Community Snapshots: Recent Immigrants Living in York Region*, a Regional report on immigration.
