**Subject**                      **Senior Citizens Government Pension Income**

**Summary**                      For the period October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2002 to December 31, 2002, the guaranteed income levels have changed.

**Background**                      The Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario Senior Citizens represents the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens.

GAINS Rate Tables are sent out quarterly from the Ministry of Finance.

**Update**                              The guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens for the period of October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2002 to December 31, 2002 are as follows:
