Please bring the following items to your appointment:

- ▶ Two pieces of proper photo ID for yourself and all family members (i.e. birth certificates, health cards);
- ▶ Letter from your employer on company letterhead stating: history of employment, hourly wage and weekly hours;
- ▶ One month's most recent pay cheque stubs;
- ▶ Proof of rent or mortgage paid;
- ▶ Eviction notice(s) and/or "N4", formal document which specifies that you have already been through tribunal;
- ▶ If renting, proof of rental history for one year;
- ▶ Rental Promissory Note;
- ▶ Landlord's full name, address and telephone number;
- ▶ All bills/notifications including credit cards, utilities, medical, loans, etc.;
- ▶ Proof of any and all sources of income (i.e. child support, unemployment benefits);
- ▶ Updated bankbook(s);
- ▶ Any other expenses (monthly or outstanding).
