Summary	For the period April 1, 2005 to June 30, 2005, the guaranteed income levels have changed.
Background	<p>The Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario Senior Citizens represents the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens.</p> <p>GAINS Rate Tables are sent out quarterly from the Ministry of Finance.</p>
Update	The guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens for the period of April 1, 2005 to June 30, 2005 are as follows:

OAS – Old Age Security	\$ 473.65	\$ 473.65	\$ 947.30
GIS – Guaranteed Income Supplement	562.93	366.67	733.34
