A Special Permit is required to undertake any clear cutting, and is assessed against current Regional policy and principles. If the area to be cleared is less than 0.2 hectares, Regional Staff can review and make a decision on the application. If the area to be cleared is greater than 0.2 hectares staff will report to Regional Council who will make the decision on the application.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

*** NO TREE INJURY OR DESTRUCTION CAN OCCUR UNTIL A PERMIT HAS BEEN ISSUED**

- * A Scoped Environmental Impact study must be submitted with the application. Please contact Regional Forestry Staff for study requirements.
- * Limitations on the tree removal will be indicated as conditions of the permit, and may vary, depending on the scope of work.
- * ALL sections of the application are to be completed in full and fees attached. An incomplete application will not be processed and will be returned to the applicant.
- * Prior to the submitting your application you are required to review The Regional Municipality of York, Forest Conservation By-law TR-0004-2005-36 be reviewed.

EFFECTIVE DATES OF PERMIT

This type of permit is valid for 1 year after approval. This office should be notified if the harvest is delayed or an extension is required for

DESCRIPTION OF AREA

The Description of Area is to include a hand drawn map of directions to the woodland, which includes:

- Location and name of surrounding roads
- Woodland/or woodlot to be harvested
- Property Boundaries
- Buildings on properties
- North Arrow
- Preferred access points for inspection purposes.

FEES

There are 2 Fee classes for Special permits.

Permits issued under subsection 5.8 of the By-law (greater than 0.2 hectare)	\$500.00
Permits issued under subsection 5.9 of the By-law (equal to or less than 0.2 hectare)	\$250.00

If the owner is a bona fide farmer as demonstrated by providing a "Farm Business Registration Number" on the application the permit fee will be \$25.00

The By-law is available upon request.
