- a) The stopping up and closing of that part of Major Mackenzie Drive (Y.R. 25), in the Town of Markham, in The Regional Municipality of York being Part of the Original Road Allowance between Lots 20 and 21 and Part of Lots 20 and 21, Concession 7, Town of Markham and designated as Part 1 on a draft Reference Plan prepared by Lloyd & Purcell Ltd. and dated January 8, 2003 subject to an easement for the existing watermain and less any land required for a 0.3 meter reserve across the Regional road frontage.

Islington Avenue at Thistlewood Avenue

5. The Director of Realty Services be authorized to execute and serve any notices required by the *Expropriations Act*.
6. Authority be granted for the introduction of the necessary bills in Council to give effect to the foregoing.
