Summary	For the period April 1 st , 2011 to June 30, 2011, the guaranteed income levels have changed.
Background	<p>The Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario Senior Citizens represents the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens.</p> <p>GAINS Rate Tables are sent out quarterly from the Ministry of Finance.</p>
Update	The guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens for the period of April 1 st , 2011 to June 30, 2011 are as follows:
