**1. Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Status Report 13**

March 22, 2007, recommending that:

1. Staff continue to provide regular updates on the priority projects linked to the release of additional capacity, with the next report to be submitted in September, 2007.
2. Staff continue discussions with the local municipalities with respect to infrastructure completion dates and various planning approvals.
3. The Regional Clerk forward this report to the Clerks of the Municipalities of Vaughan, Markham, Richmond Hill, Aurora, Newmarket, East Gwillimbury, King and Whitchurch-Stouffville.

**2. Transfer of Watermain (Norman Drive, Keele Street, Hoop Street, King Road and Fisher Street) To The Township of King 33**

March 20, 2007, recommending that:

1. York Region agree to a request from the Township of King to transfer from the Region to the Township the 300mm watermain along Norman Drive, Keele Street (Y.R. 6), Hoop Street, King Road (Y.R. 11) and Fisher Street.
2. The Regional Solicitor prepare the necessary by-law to give effect to the foregoing.
3. The Regional Clerk forward this report to the Clerk of the Township of King.

**3. York Region and Local Municipal Sanitary Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Program 45**

March 20, 2007, recommending that:

1. The Regional Clerk forward this report to the Clerks of the local municipalities seeking local municipal participation in the proposed program to reduce inflow and infiltration.

**4. Nashville Road** **51**

1. Truck Route guidance signs be installed at key intersection locations on the Regional road network to promote trucks to use Rutherford Road between Highway 27 (Y.R. 27) and Highway 50, in the City of Vaughan,
2. The existing speed limit of 80-km per hour on Nashville Road (Y.R. 49) from the east limit of Highway 50 to 1200 metres east of the east limit of Highway 50, be reduced to 70-km per hour, in the City of Vaughan.
