

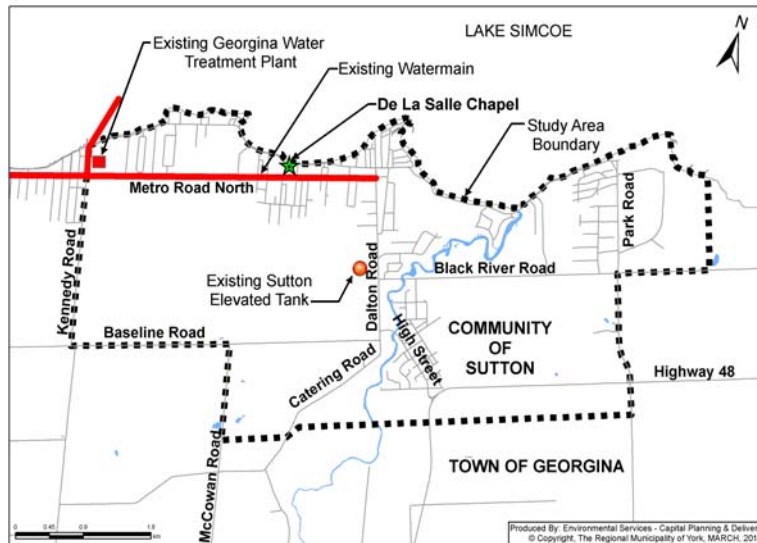

CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY FOR SUTTON WATER SERVICING IN THE TOWN OF GEORGINA

The Regional Municipality of York (York Region) is planning to expand the existing Regional water system in the community of Sutton, in the Town of Georgina. The existing Regional watermain on Metro Road North will be extended into the Sutton Community (the Project). The current study area for this Project is shown below.



The Project was identified in York Region's Water and Wastewater Master Plan Update (November 2009) as a need to meet growth demand for the area. York Region initiated a Class Environmental Assessment study (Class EA) for this Project under Schedule B of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (October 2000, as amended in 2007) in March 2011.

Consultation with, and input from the public and government review agencies is a vital component of the Class EA. Members of the public and review agencies are invited to provide comment for incorporation into the overall planning and preliminary design of the Project.

As part of the Class EA process, York Region will be hosting a Public Information Centre on the Project to engage residents and stakeholders on any issues. All those with an interest in the Project are urged to attend.
