BY-LAW NO. A-0280-2000-077

A by-law to assume the power to provide
public transportation services and facilities

WHEREAS Section 209.2 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45 (the “Act”) provides that an upper-tier municipality may pass a by-law to assume a local power to provide a prescribed service or facility for all of its local municipalities;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Ontario Regulation 215/96 made under the Act, public transportation services and facilities are prescribed as services and facilities for which an upper-tier municipality may assume local powers under Section 209.2 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Regional Municipality of York desires to assume the power to provide public transportation facilities from its area municipalities;

Now, therefore, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The Regional Corporation hereby assumes from all its area municipalities the power to provide public transportation services and facilities effective January 1, 2001 or such other date as may be established by resolution of Regional Council (the “Effective Date”).
2. On the Effective Date:
 - (a) all rights and obligations and all assets and liabilities, including all real and personal property of the area municipalities pertaining to or used for public transportation services and facilities shall vest in the Regional Corporation,

subject to such terms and conditions, including payment of compensation, as may be mutually agreed; and

- (b) the interest and obligation of each area municipality in any agreement, purchase order or lease respecting the provision of public transportation services and facilities shall be assumed by the Regional Corporation and the respective area municipality shall be relieved of all liability under such agreements.
