



LEED Certification

The McCleary Court Community Environmental Centre has been designed to achieve certification in the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System. This system is a benchmark for design, construction and operation of green buildings.

Examples of the measures taken at the CEC towards sustainability include:

- Energy efficient heating and lighting
- Stormwater management ponds to control runoff
- Rainwater collected for use in washrooms and irrigation system
- Low-flow faucets and showerheads
- Ground source heat pump
- Local and recycled materials used for construction
- Increased natural lighting

Reuse Partners

York Region has partnered with both Goodwill Industries and Habitat for Humanity York Region. They will be permanently located on-site to collect a wide range of reusable goods including:

- Clothing and textiles
- Housewares
- Books, CDs and DVDs
- Renovation and building materials
- Plumbing and lighting fixtures

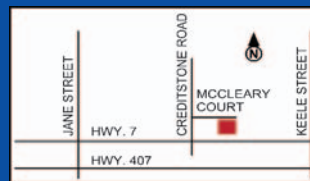
April 1st to October 31st, McCleary Court CEC will remain open until 7:00 p.m. on Thursdays.

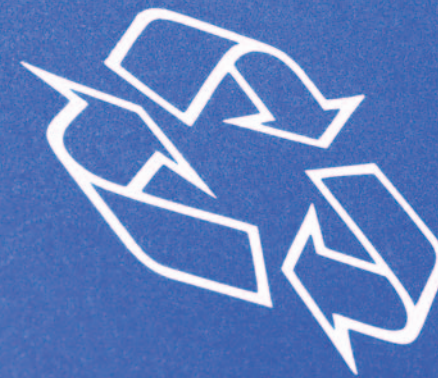

What is a Community Environmental Centre?

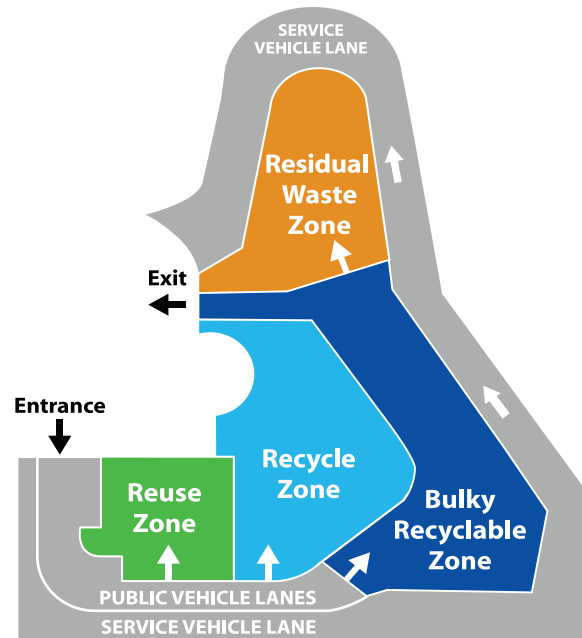
Community Environmental Centres (CECs) provide residents with a convenient location to drop off a variety of materials, including those not easily managed through the current waste collection programs, such as bulky materials, shredded paper and electronics.

In turn, residents are able to manage their waste more effectively while increasing their community's ability to divert waste from disposal.

CECs provide an opportunity to divert more waste from disposal through reuse and recycling, contributing to York Region's overall waste diversion goals.

CECs are intended for York Region residents and small business use only. Large commercial vehicles are not permitted to use the drop-off facility.

* Electronics limited to 4 computers/monitors, 2 televisions and up to 6 other units of electronic equipment per visit.

Please drop off shredded paper in clear plastic bags.

Please drop off styrofoam in clear plastic bags.

* Businesses with larger quantities of tires can register as "collectors" with Ontario Tire Stewardship at www.ontariotires.ca or by calling 1-888-OTS-2202. Collectors are entitled to free pick up of tires depending on quantity and type collected.

Loads larger than a 14 foot cube van or unloading with a hydraulic lift are not permitted. Please use the Georgina Transfer Station. Cash, MasterCard, Visa and debit cards accepted.

Materials Not Accepted X

- Household Hazardous Waste (bring your HHW to one of York Region's four public drop-off depots)
- Green Bin organic wastes
- Industrial wastes
- Large loads (greater than a 14 foot cube van) need to be delivered to an alternate site
- Yard Waste
Due to the presence of the Asian Long-Horned Beetle, City of Vaughan residents are encouraged to manage their yard waste through their local municipal curbside program. Please contact York Region for alternate locations, disposal requirements and hours of operation.
