Nipissing District Development Screens™ (NDDS™) are checklists to help you find out if your child is developing as expected. The YES or NO questions measure your child's abilities in a number of key areas. If one or more NO responses are marked, talk to a health care professional about your concerns.

Checklists are available at no charge in English, French, Chinese, Spanish and Vietnamese, for the following ages:

- 1 & 2 months, 4 months, 6 months, 9 months,
- 12 months, 15 months, 18 months, 24 months,
- 30 months, 3 years, 4 years, 5 years and 6 years
