Introduction

The Regional Municipality of York is one of six Regional Governments in Ontario. Twenty-one Regional Council members (including the Mayors of the nine-area municipalities: Aurora, East Gwillimbury, Georgina, King Township, Markham, Newmarket, Richmond Hill, Vaughan and Whitchurch-Stouffville) set policies, direction and budgets for York Region. Members of Regional Council represent their constituents at the local municipal and regional level for a four-year term.
