York Region students learn how to *Party in the Right Spirit* *Students from 18 local schools participate in annual safer prom workshop*

NEWMARKET – The Regional Municipality of York Community and Health Services department will host the 9th annual *Party in the Right Spirit* interactive workshop on Wednesday, March 26th. This event will inform, educate and help high school students and school staff advisors plan a safer prom or graduation. This year, 18 schools will participate in the event.

Prom-related concerns including impairment, substance use, legal liabilities, sexual assault, relationship issues and violence will be addressed. Through a series of workshops, the event identifies strategies to avoid or manage potential problems.

Most proms are school-sponsored, supervised events where the serving and possession of alcohol is strictly prohibited: However, alcohol and other substances may be available at pre and post-prom parties. The *Party in the Right Spirit* workshop is being offered to equip high school prom/graduation planning committees with techniques to raise student awareness about making responsible, informed decisions at these parties.
