FOR APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH**

**2. Expansion of Public Health Dental Services to Low-Income Children 105**

September 2, 2010, recommending that:

1. Council approve an amendment to the Region's approved 2010 Capital Budget to include additional expenditures of \$252,473 for one-time capital equipment and leasehold improvement costs offset by 100% provincial funding in order to implement the Low-Income Dental Program, with no tax levy impact.
2. Council approve additional operating expenditures (including staffing costs) to begin implementation of program activities related to the Low-Income Dental Program in 2010 of up to \$592,649 offset by 100% provincial funding with no tax levy impact.
3. The 2011 Operating Budget for the Public Health Branch include the annual operating costs related to the Low-Income Dental program, offset by 100% provincial funding with no tax levy impact.
4. The Commissioner of Community and Health Services be authorized to execute any agreements required by the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care in relation to the Low-Income Dental Program.

**3. Investing in our Communities:  
The Community and Health Services Multi-Year Plan 113**

September 1, 2010, recommending that:

1. Regional Council approve the Community and Health Services Multi-Year Plan entitled *Investing in Our Communities: A Multi-Year Plan for the Community and Health Services Department 2010-2015 (see Council Attachment 1)*, which includes actions on the following six Goals:
