BY-LAW NO. R-1232(a)-2006-101

A by-law to amend By-law No. R-1232-2000-074
being a by-law regulating signs on regional roads

The Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law No. R-1232-2000-074 (the “By-law”) is hereby amended as set out in this by-law.
2. Section 1.1 of the By-law is hereby amended by adding the following:
“h) “election sign” means a sign advertising or promoting a registered candidate in a federal, provincial or municipal election, including an election of a local board or commission.”
3. The By-law is hereby amended by inserting the following:
“2.5 Subject to Section 2.4, and despite any other provision to the contrary in this by-law, election signs may be placed on regional roads during the period commencing six weeks prior to election day for the applicable election and ending 72 hours following the close of polls on the day of the election, provided that:
 - a) the placement of the sign complies with section 3.1 of this by-law;
 - b) despite section 4.1 of this by-law, no more than one (1) sign per registered candidate shall be permitted at any corner of an intersection;
 - c) sections 5 and 6 of this by-law shall not apply to election signs; and
 - d) except as amended as herein, all other provisions of this by-law shall apply to election signs.”
