Public Consultation Centres**

*Planning for Tomorrow* serves as York Region’s growth management plan. It will guide the Region’s infrastructure needs for water, sewers, roads and transit for the next 30 years. The Infrastructure (water, wastewater, and transportation) master plan update studies are being conducted concurrently and as the public consultations are key components of these studies, the public is invited to review information, discuss issues, and propose solutions to address our future infrastructure needs and challenges at our first Public Consultation Centres (PCCs) for Transportation and Water & Wastewater, scheduled for November 21, 22, and 23, 2006 (see details below). The date, time, and location of future meetings will be posted on the Region’s website and in local papers.

Public consultation for the update to York Region’s water efficiency program, *Water for Tomorrow*, will also be part of this round of Public Consultation Centres. After eight years of providing award winning water efficiency programs, York Region is updating the Water Efficiency Master Plan to develop incentive and educational programs for the future.

- Attend our PCCs - the first PCC will provide interested parties with the opportunity to comment and identify issues that should be considered in the Region’s Master Plan Studies. The meeting will be held at three locations from 6:00pm to 9:00pm.
