Subject Senior Citizens Government Pension Income

Summary For the period October 1st, 2010 to December 31, 2010, the guaranteed income levels have changed.

Background The Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario Senior Citizens represents the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens.

GAINS Rate Tables are sent out quarterly from the Ministry of Finance.

Update The guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens for the period of October 1st, 2010 to December 31, 2010 are as follows:
