

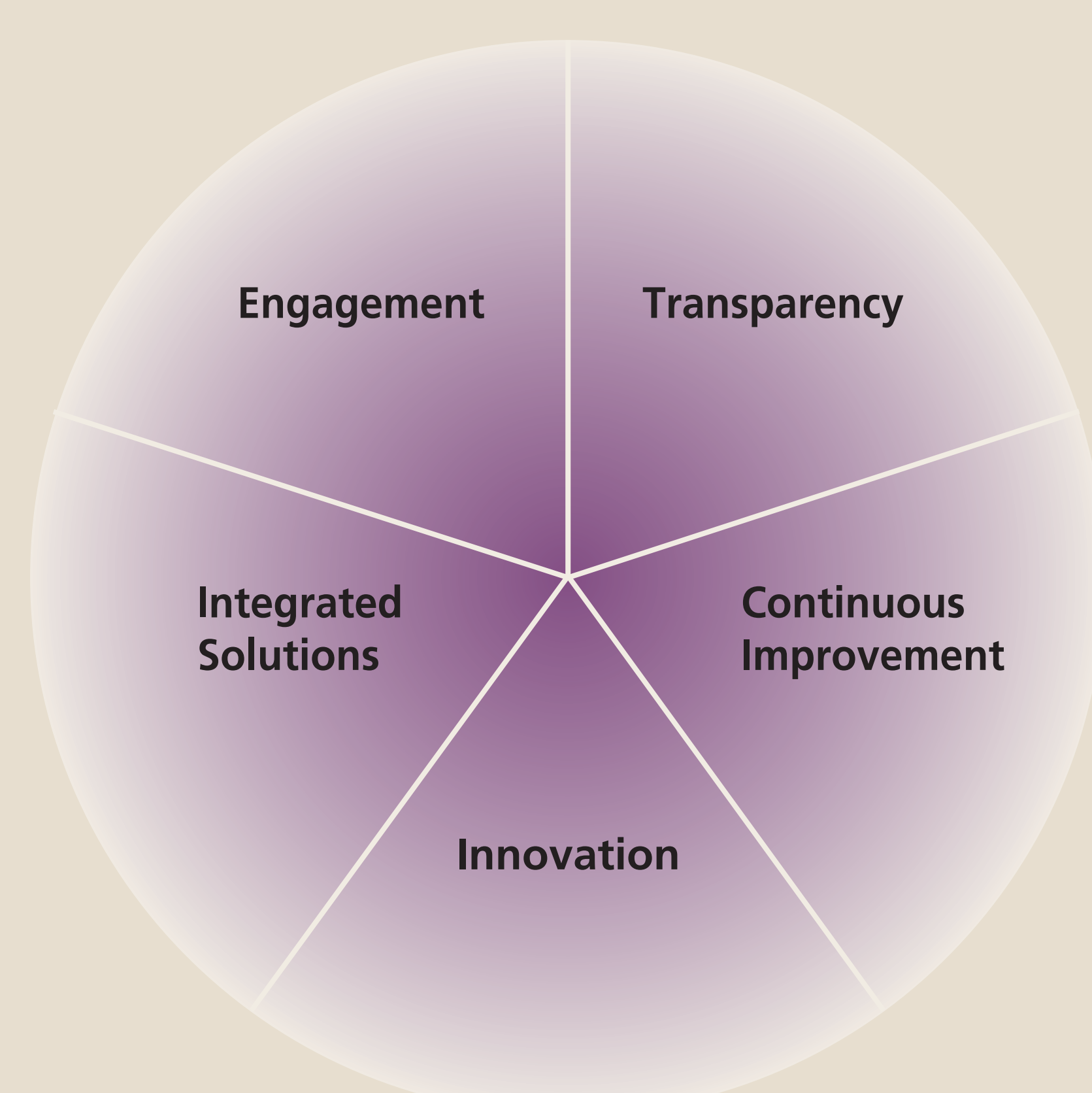
Chapter 8 - Implementation
