Establishing Speed Limits on Regional Roads

January 26, 2010, recommending that:

1. The Regional Clerk forward this report to the Clerks of the local municipalities in York Region requesting their review and comment by the fall of this year.
2. Regional staff report back to Committee in 2011 summarizing the results of this review.

**2. Speed Limit Revisions and Review
Various Regional Roads**

January 26, 2010, recommending that:

1. The existing speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour on Park Road (Y.R. 18) from Black River Road (Y.R. 80) to Hedge Road be reduced to 60 kilometres per hour, in the Town of Georgina.
2. The existing speed limit of 40 kilometres per hour on Bayview Avenue (Y.R. 34) from 50 metres south of the south limit of Windhurst Gate to 50 metres north of the north limit of North Taylor Mills Drive, be increased to 60 kilometres per hour, in the Town of Richmond Hill.
3. The existing speed limit of 70 kilometres per hour on 16th Avenue (Y.R. 73) from Highway 48 to Heritage Corners Lane be decreased to 60 kilometres per hour, in the Town of Markham.
4. The Regional Solicitor prepare the necessary by-law.
5. The Regional Clerk forward this report to the Clerks of the local municipalities and to the Chief of York Regional Police.

**3. Municipal Streetscape Partnership Program
2009 Project Recommendation**
