## **EARTH HOUR**

At 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 29, 2008, millions of people in some of the world's major cities will turn off their lights for one hour (Earth Hour) to show support for taking action on climate change.

Earth Hour is a global initiative started by the World Wildlife Fund (WWF). More than 15 major cities are participating in Canada and abroad, and more are joining daily.

The Regional Municipality of York is a registered participant of Earth Hour and we will be turning off all non-essential lights at the Administration Centre and other regional facilities where possible on March 29th.

We encourage housing providers and tenants to turn off non-essential lights for one hour between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on March 29th.
