Funding Opportunities for Non Profit Organizations – Improve accessibility for people with disabilities

1. Social Development Partnerships Program – Disability Component (SDPP-D)

SDPP-D helps to ensure that people with disabilities benefit from the same quality of life as all Canadians. The program supports a wide range of community-based initiatives that address social issues and barriers facing people with disabilities.

Non-profit organizations are invited to apply for funding through calls of proposal. The SDPP-D is providing \$9 million in funding over three years for projects that respond to the social development needs and goals of people with disabilities by supporting innovative solutions to remove barriers through improved access to programs and services.

- Incorporated for one year (or longer);
- A non-profit or service organization representing a sector, industry or professions; and/or,
- A non-government organization.
