



YORK DURHAM SEWAGE SYSTEM UPPER YORK SEWAGE SOLUTIONS

The Upper York Sewage Solutions (UYSS) capital works project will identify and provide long-term sewage conveyance and/or treatment options to service the 2031 growth-approved areas of Aurora, Newmarket and parts of East Gwillimbury (Holland Landing, Queensville and Sharon). The project will proceed through and adhere to the guidelines and principles of an Individual Environmental Assessment (IEA).

All work relating to the UYSS project will be carried out while adhering to all relevant Provincial mandates including:

- Oak Ridges Moraine Act
- Clean Water Act
- Source Water Protection
- Sustainability Principles
- Greenbelt Act
- The Great Lakes Charter.

The Terms of Reference, a document acting as a blueprint for the preparation of the Environmental Assessment, has been approved as amended by the Ministry of the Environment and work is proceeding on the preparation of the Environmental Assessment.

The Environmental Assessment is a multi-year project and is anticipated to be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment for approval in late 2012.

Current estimate: \$300-\$400 million
