### EXAMPLES OF HHW INCLUDE:

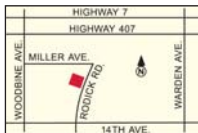
- Alkyd and lead based paints\*

- Pool chemicals, propane tanks

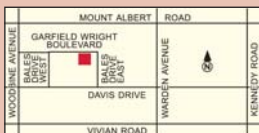
## Where Can I Take My HHW?
