

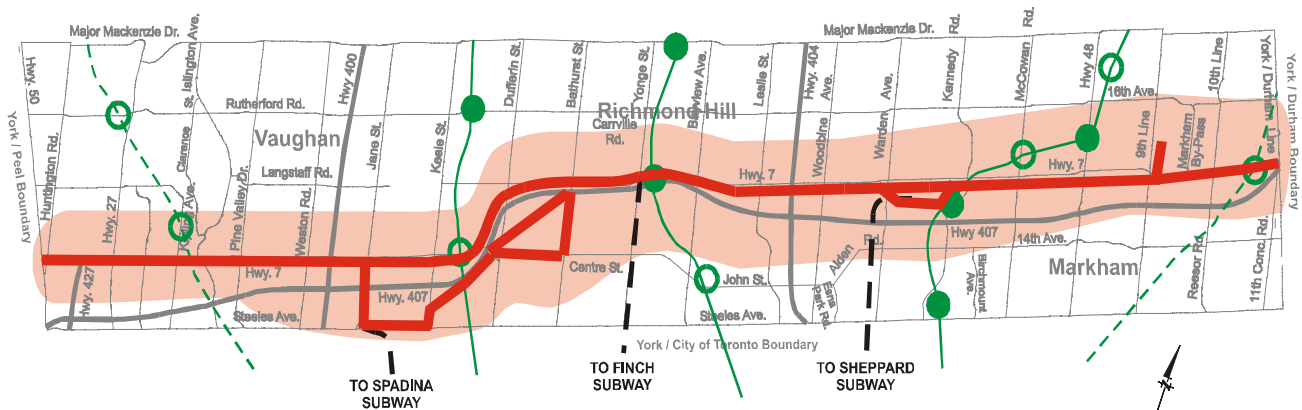
# Notice of Submission

## Terms of Reference

### Highway 7 Corridor Transitway

As part of the Highway 7 Corridor Transitway planning process, Terms of Reference (ToR) were recently submitted to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) for formal review as required under the provincial *Environmental Assessment Act*. If approved, the ToR will serve as a benchmark for the preparation and review of the environmental assessment (EA) document for this undertaking.

The Highway 7 Corridor Transitway is intended to extend the influence of the Regional rapid transit network in order to substantially increase transit ridership within York Region. If approved, the proposed undertaking and its alternatives will be located within the Highway 7 Corridor between the York/Peel Boundary (Highway 50) and the York/Durham Boundary (York/Durham Line), as identified in the map below.
