

How to correctly use hand sanitizer

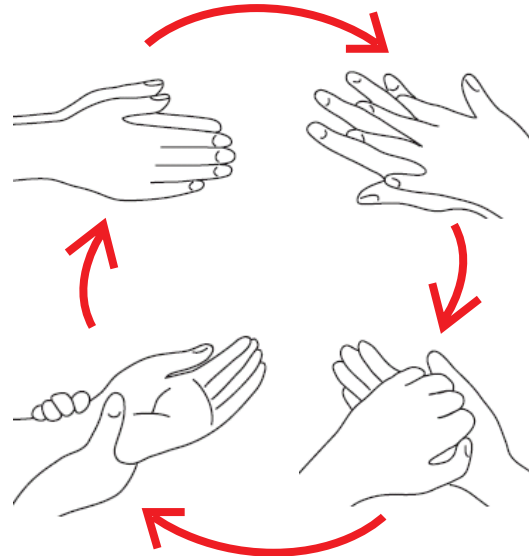
STEP 1

Apply one squirt



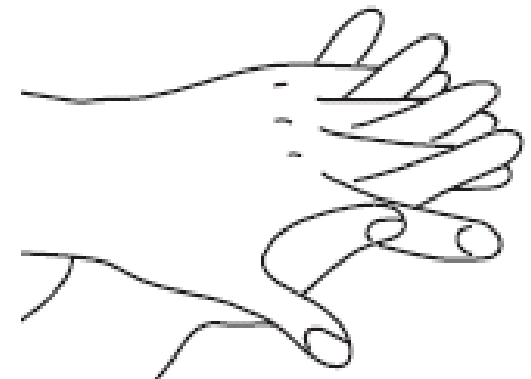
STEP 2

Rub hands together



STEP 3

Rub until dry



SOME IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Use hand sanitizer when:
 - soap and running water are not available (e.g., field trips, at the mall)
 - your hands are not visibly dirty
- Choose an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains 60-90% alcohol
- Do not apply hand sanitizer near an open flame
- Children should be supervised when using hand sanitizer product

Note: alcohol-based hand sanitizer dispensers should be kept at least three feet (0.9 metres) from any open flame or other ignition source (e.g., electrical outlet, light switch).
