Summary	For the period July 1, 2004 to September 30, 2004, the guaranteed income levels have changed.
Background	<p>The Guaranteed Annual Income System (GAINS) for Ontario Senior Citizens represents the maximum guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens.</p> <p>GAINS Rate Tables are sent out quarterly from the Ministry of Finance.</p>
Update	The guaranteed monthly income amounts payable to eligible Senior Citizens for the period of July 1, 2004 to September 30, 2004 are as follows:

OAS – Old Age Security	\$466.63	\$466.63	\$933.26
GIS – Guaranteed Income Supplement	554.59	361.24	722.48
GAINS – Guaranteed Annual Income System	83.00	83.00	166.00
TOTAL	\$1,104.22	\$910.87	\$1,821.74
