

NOTICE OF FACILITY UPGRADE

**ANSNORVELDT WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM
STANDBY POWER UPGRADES
TOWN OF KING**

The Regional Municipality of York (the Region) is planning to complete the design for standby power upgrades at the Ansnorveldt Pumping Station, 19106 Dufferin Street in the Township of King. The existing generator and associated power distribution requires upgrading to meet the future needs of the Ansnorveldt water distribution system and its associated emergency response requirements.

The project is being planned under **Schedule A+** of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007)* under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*. Public and review agencies are invited to provide input and comment for incorporation into the overall planning and design for the standby power upgrades.

The construction phase of the project will be undertaken over the next few months and it is anticipated that there will be minimal to no disruption to nearby residences during construction.
