NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY FOR THE WOODRIVER BEND PUMPING STATION STANDBY POWER UPGRADES TOWN OF GEORGINA

The Regional Municipality of York (York Region) is planning to complete the design for standby power upgrades at the Woodriver Bend Pumping Station in the Town of Georgina. The existing diesel generator originally installed in 1992 is approaching its design life and may need to be replaced as preventative maintenance to ensure the station has reliable standby power.

York Region has initiated a study in compliance with the Municipal Engineers Association "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment," (October 2000, as amended 2007).

The project is being planned under **Schedule B** of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (June 2000) under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*. Public and review agencies are invited to provide input and comment for incorporation into the overall planning and design for the standby power upgrades.

Additional notices will be advertised to inform and to solicit further input from the public. Subject to the results of the environmental assessment study, it is anticipated that the construction of the upgrades may begin as early as November 2010.

The study will be undertaken over the next few months. Consultation with and input from the public and government review agencies will be a vital component of the study.
