BY-LAW NO. 2009-55

A by-law to amend By-law No. S-0064-2005-009, being a by-law to regulate the discharge of sewage and land drainage in The Regional Municipality of York

WHEREAS on January 20, 2005 Regional Council enacted By-law No. S-0064-2005-009, being a by-law to regulate the discharge of sewage and land drainage in The Regional Municipality of York (the “By-law”);

AND WHEREAS this amending by-law is required to provide greater operational flexibility by authorizing the Commissioner responsible for enforcing the By-law to designate Regional employees for the purposes of enforcing the By-law;

AND WHEREAS in order to effect this change, sections 13.1 and 14.1 and Schedule “E” of the By-law must be amended accordingly.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. The wording of Section 13.1 of the By-law is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with “The Commissioner with the responsibility for the By-law has the authority to appoint employees of the Region to act in the capacity of Provincial Offences Officers for the purpose of enforcing this by-law and such an appointment may also be rescinded by the Commissioner.”;
2. Section 14.1 of the By-law is hereby amended by deleting ““C”, “D” and “E”” and inserting in lieu ““C” and “D””; and
3. Schedule “E” of the By-law is hereby deleted in its entirety.
