York Region Public Health developed and information package for owners/operators of Personal Service Settings (PSS) to support you in the daily operations of your premises.

Our common goal is to ensure a safe environment to protect yourself and your clients from exposure to blood borne infections such as hepatitis B, hepatitis C, human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or other infectious agents such as bacteria and fungi.

Do you own/operate a Personal Service Setting?

Personal Service Settings include any premises that offers personal services where there is a risk of exposure to blood or body fluids and includes. Examples of these services include, but are not limited to, hairdressing and barbering, tattooing, body piercing, nail services, microblading and microneedling.

What this package includes

This package includes information about your legal responsibilities under the <u>Health Protection</u> <u>and Promotion Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.H. 7 ("HPPA")</u> and <u>Ontario Regulation 136/18</u>, and the role of the Public Health Inspector to ensure these requirements are met. It also includes <u>resources</u> to help you prevent the spread of infections at your premises.

Reminder to Notify Public Health

Owners/operators of PSS are required to notify York Region Public Health at least 14 days before starting operation of a new premises, providing additional services and/or construction or renovation of your premises. Refer to <u>Personal Service Settings Notification of Intention</u>.

Upon receiving notification, a Public Health Inspector will conduct routine inspections of your premises and will be available to answer questions you may have.
