BYLAW NO. 2015-76

A bylaw to establish the Water Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund

WHEREAS Regional Council has determined that a reserve fund be established to prevent fluctuations in water rates as a result of unforeseen expenditures;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. A reserve fund to be known as the Water Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund is hereby established.
- 2. The Water Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund shall be operated and maintained from:
 - a. appropriations made from time to time from the current estimates of the Region;
 - b. the allocation from such sources of revenue as may be determined by Regional Council; and
 - c. the earnings derived from the investment of monies held in the reserve fund.
- 3. The Water Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund shall be used to prevent fluctuations in water rates as a result of unforeseen expenditures and/or revenue shortfalls.
- 4. Interest shall accrue on the balance outstanding in the Water Rate Stabilization Reserve Fund in accordance with investment policies approved by Regional Council.
