




### York Region Broadband Strategy: Objectives

#### Vision Statement:


To establish York Region as a Gigabit Region, recognized for its leadership in fostering an eco-system of collaboration and business innovation within a connected lifestyle community.

# Identified market opportunities for residential and business areas


### York Region Broadband Strategy: Analysis



- **Overall Target:** improved connectivity across the Region.
- Major Focus Areas:
  - Employment Lands
  - Centres and Corridors
  - Rural Communities
- Certain areas have been identified for greater connectivity due to:
  - Ability to complement municipal planning goals
  - > Ability to improve economic development
  - Ease of investment and availability of infrastructure

Identified potential connectivity speed targets

### York Region Broadband Strategy: Analysis



#### A hierarchy of approaches:

- 1. Private Investment aim is to get private sector to make investment.
- 2. Public-Private if hurdle rate can't be met, explore public-private partnership.
- 3. Public if public-private won't work, explore public investment.

#### • Approach to engaging investments:

- Engage telecommunications firms on opportunities.
- Provide detailed demographic (household density, population, etc.) and business data to help develop business plan.
- Find ways to ease investment process (approval process, shared infrastructure, etc.)

Leveraging and harmonizing municipal processes and investments can enable private sector investments in connectivity infrastructure

### York Region Broadband Strategy: Outcomes

### **Infrastructure Investment Priorities Activities**

- ORION Point of Presence (PoP) at Southlake Regional Health Centre
  - PoP Installation and Connection to York University
- Ongoing engagement with Local Municipalities and Internet Service Providers (ISPs)
- YTN Review (Next Report to Regional Council Q1- 2016)

Ensuring public and private sector investments are directed to where they will be most effective in improving connectivity is important for efficiently meeting current and future needs
