WHAT ARE THE RECOMMENDATIONS TO INCREASE CHILDREN'S ACTIVE PLAY?

- Investigate and identify interventions to overcome the barrier of inclement weather at school and at home
- Encourage parents/caregivers to limit scheduled activities and provide more free time for children to play
- Support teachers to incorporate more active play during class time
- Implement interventions to reduce children's use of media devices
- Raise parents/caregivers and school staff awareness of the benefits versus the risks of outdoor play
