An FLP can build your design to specifications and transform your outdoor space into the landscape of your dreams.


Maintenance

Rain chains can be used in place of traditional downspouts to direct water where you need it while adding an artistic touch.

PERMEABLE PAVERS/ PAVEMENT Pavement made of porous materials allows rainwater and air to move freely through and into the soil, reducing the amount of runoff from your property.

3 RAIN GARDEN Rain gardens and infiltration areas can be created to fit any style and are an attractive addition to your landscape. Rainwater from downspouts is directed to the rain garden and soaks into the ground slowly instead of being directed to the storm sewer.

4 BIOSWALE

Bioswales are designed to mimic the water cycle by using plants to naturally filter rainwater as it slowly seeps into the ground.

5 TREATMENT TRAIN

A sequence of two or more Fusion elements designed to capture, move, clean, and re-use water.

6 RIGHT PLANT, RIGHT PLACE Matching a plants needs to the conditions that it will be growing in will help plants thrive and look their best. Always check plant tags before you buy to be sure there is an appropriate spot in your garden for them.

7 DOWNSPOUT DISCONNECTION

Downspout disconnection is the process of separating a downspout from the stormwater sewer system and re-directing it to another location such as a lawn or garden. If a downspout goes straight into the ground, it is likely connected to the storm sewer.

RAIN BARREL

Rain barrels are used to capture rainwater from downspouts that can be used later. There are many different varieties available to suit your style, ranging from simple to decorative.

Spend less time working and more time enjoying your yard. Mulch is a great way to reduce the amount of maintenance your garden needs. It will help to keep moisture in the soil, reduce weed growth and protect plant roots which will result in stronger, healthier plants.

- Apply a layer of five to ten centimetres of mulch to the exposed soil of your garden beds.
- Organic mulches like wood chips, are a great choice because they add nutrients to your soil as they break down.

Teaching your kids to grow and care for plants will give them a better understanding of nature and our environment. A great way to involve your children and get their creativity flowing is to create a hanging basket or decorative planter.

- Container plantings are a great way to add a pop of colour to a dull space.
- Look for plants that can withstand the summer heat and require minimal watering, such as Agave.
- Don't be afraid to try something new! Succulent planters are a great alternative to traditional planters.

- Planting a variety of colourful native flowers in your garden, such as Milkweed and Butterfly Weed will provide a great source of food for many different pollinators.
- Wait until spring to cut back your plants. They can provide a shelter for insects and a food source for birds during the winter.

- Use cool colours to create a peaceful, relaxing garden.
