Communications Toolkit

We have prepared this information for you to promote awareness of York Region's Cold Weather Response Plan that will provide safe and welcoming spaces for residents experiencing homelessness during the cold weather season. The 2021-2022 Plan has been modified to mitigate risks associated with COVID-19. While the COVID-19 pandemic continues to present challenges for all residents in York Region, it has had a disproportionate impact on vulnerable populations, including people experiencing homelessness.

York Region will issue a Cold Weather Alert when temperatures are forecast to be -15°C or colder, with or without wind chill, for any local municipality in the Region.

All individuals and couples without children seeking shelter during a Cold Weather Alert are asked to contact the Transitional Shelter Intake Line at 1-877-464-9675 ext. 76140 or email TransitionalShelter.Line@york.ca. The Transitional Shelter Intake Line will be answered by Salvation Army Transitional Shelter staff 24/7.

All families with children seeking shelter during a Cold Weather Alert are asked to contact Leeder Place Family Shelter at 1-888-554-5525, which is answered by Blue Door staff.

KEY MESSAGES

Cold Weather Alerts

- Cold Weather Alerts are issued by the Regional Municipality of York when temperatures are forecast to reach -15°C or colder, with or without wind chill, for any local municipality in the Region
- York Region funds emergency housing facilities and seasonal shelter programs that provide a safe place for residents to stay when they experience homelessness
- To align with Public Health Guidelines and further support residents, York Region partnered with Kingbridge Conference Centre and Hotel and the Salvation Army York Housing and Support Service to provide a temporary transitional shelter for residents experiencing homelessness
- All programs have been modified to align with Public Health Guidelines regarding COVID-19
- In the event that the Transitional Shelter, Leeder Place Family Shelter, seasonal shelter programs, and hotels exceed overflow capacity, York Region can activate additional services so that no one is left out in the cold this winter
- Residents experiencing homelessness will not be turned away without being offered assistance during Cold Weather Alerts
- York Region's Outreach Workers connect with people living outside and are largely successful
 in getting them to come into the Transitional Shelter or a seasonal shelter during Cold Weather
 Alerts

 NOTE: Individuals who need to stay at one of York Region's Emergency Housing
 Facilities will need to first self-isolate at the Transitional Shelter and have a negative
 COVID test

Street Outreach

 York Region funds a street outreach van (operated by LOFT/Crosslinks) that provides mobile services for residents experiencing homelessness or are street involved at no cost

- The van is equipped with:
 - Food
 - Clothing and shoes
 - Sleeping bags, tents, tarps and blankets
 - Harm reduction supplies
- The van operates seven days a week from 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., excluding holidays
