Help us plan the new South York Greenway - a cycling, pedestrian and micromobility route that is more than 50 kilometres long.

The route will connect York Region's western and eastern borders from the City of Vaughan, to the City of Richmond Hill and the City of Markham. Once completed, it will be an important active transportation connection to major mobility hubs, Region-wide trails and other key destinations such as the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre, Richmond Hill Centre and Markham Centre.

York Region is in the process of completing a Feasibility Study for this project which will identify a preferred route, potential connections, preliminary design features,

cost estimates and how it will be implemented across the Region.

This route will have a positive impact on the way you live and move around the Region. That's why we want to hear from you to better understand local opportunities, community priorities and expectations for the project.
