Summary Description of the IPAC Lapse

As a result of a complaint received on June 2, 2022, York Region Public Health conducted an initial inspection at the premise on June 3, 2022, with a follow-up inspection conducted on June 07, 2022. York Region Public Health noted concerns with reprocessing of re-usable non-critical and semi-critical equipment/devices. Operator failed to ensure disinfectants are used per manufacturers' instructions for use (MIFU) for non-critical and semi-critical items. Operator failed to ensure reprocessing sink is dedicated. Within reprocessing area, the operator failed to ensure there is a one-way workflow from dirty to clean to prevent cross-contamination. Operator failed to ensure that the reprocessing of all equipment/devices is conducted in an area away from where personal services are being provided. Appropriate types of PPE were not provided within the reprocessing area.
