SITE PLAN DEVELOPMENT STATUS



Master Site Plan



Phase 1: UHS Parcel

- Site Plan Agreement registered in October 2019
- Construction complete including Servicing, Utilities and Landscaping

Phase 2: York Region Parcel

- Site Plan Agreement registered in December 2019
- Servicing works completed
- Building construction underway

Phase 3: Minto Parcel

 Undergoing site plan review; resubmission anticipated for March 2022



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE





- Martinway Developments Ltd. (MDL) continues to progress with work on the superstructure of the building.
- MDL's site management offices are within Heritage Village Townhouse Units 13 & 14
- Construction of twelfth structural framing floor is complete.





- Construction of 12th floor, mechanical penthouse and roof is underway
- Installation of electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC)
- Exterior cladding panels are installed up to the fourth floor and underway up to eighth floor.
- Window installation complete on ground floor.
- Once building is enclosed, work on the interior of the building will commence.



Fencing

- Minto and Martinway will look to coordinate the transfer of the fencing that Martinway has installed along the boundary of Wyndham Gardens to prevent the need to remove and reinstate new fencing.
- When Minto undertakes their development, they will need to erect fencing around the boundary of their site per Markham Building Standards.

- Minto has continued to hold conversations with neighbouring landowners and the City regarding the expansion of the parkette.
- City requires additional public frontage (onto Eureka Street) in order to accept the park as public lands.
- Discussions are ongoing and the CLC will be updated once concrete decisions have been made.

The Regional Municipality of York is pleased to provide this update on construction activity for the new affordable housing building for seniors in your community.

Housing York Inc., York Region's non-profit housing provider, is committed to being a good neighbor throughout the construction process and beyond. We will work closely with our construction partner Martinway Contracting, and the City of Markham to ensure that a comprehensive construction management plan is followed.

The health and safety of construction workers and you - our neighbours - is our top priority.

As with any construction project, you may experience some inconveniences around the site. Martinway will make every effort to minimize disruptions when possible. We appreciate your support and understanding as we bring modern affordable housing for seniors into the community.

What to expect during this phase of construction:

- · Construction of 12th floor as well as the roof and 9th floor mechanical penthouse
- Installation of electrical, plumbing and heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC)
- Window framing is underway with window installation expected to take place in January and February
- Exterior cladding (covering) installation has been completed up to the 4th floor and will continue for the remaining floors
- · Once enclosed, work will continue primarily on the interior of the building throughout the winter
- · Brief, intermittent traffic disruptions as materials and machinery are transported to and from the site
- Periods of increased noise, vibration and traffic or truck activity
- Regular road sweeping that is enhanced as needed





Martinway and York Region are taking measures to reduce impacts during this phase as much as possible. Safety is a priority. Please slow down when travelling through a construction area.

- 1. Noise from construction is extremely loud.
- 2. Will noise continue after seniors move in?
- 3. Will landscaping be complete to allow visitors and bus access?
- 4. Will it be safe for seniors to walk outside or will there be construction vehicles? Also, will there be a path for WG residents to travel to Union Villa?
- 5. Will there be electric vehicle charging stations on each floor?
- 6. Will there be senior safe induction stoves and fridges with bottom freezers?
- 7. Will sidewalks be heated in heavily used areas?



Issues/Questions We've Heard

- 8. Will there be a canopy at the front door to shelter vehicles during pick-ups?
- 9. Will there be a designated outdoor pet exercise area?
- 10. Will there be a ground floor wash station to clean pets before entering building?
- 11. Is there an update on what will be available in the Seniors Hub?
- 12. When is the seniors hub expected to begin operating recreational programs?
- 13. Does WG need to take additional steps to ensure their 2 representatives are able to be on the advisory committee for the Seniors Hub?
