## Exemption Forms for Children Attending a School or Licensed Child Care Centre

## **Students Attending School**

There are two types of immunization exemptions available:

- **Medical** A <u>Statement of Medical Exemption Form</u> may be requested when a child is not able to receive an immunization due to medical reasons, or
- **Non-medical** <u>A Statement of Conscience or Religious Belief Form</u> may be requested when a parent/guardian chooses not to immunize a child due to religious beliefs or conscience objects. A Commissioner of Taking Affidavits must sign this form.

## Mandatory Immunization Education Session (for a non-medical exemption)

Under the <u>Immunization of School Pupils Act</u> (ISPA), Ontario parents and guardians who choose not to immunize their child for **non-medical reasons** are **required to attend** an immunization education session and complete a non-medical form. York Region Public Health offers immunization education sessions for residents through a virtual, web-based video conferencing session (the sessions are no longer held in person).
