Summary Description of the IPAC Lapse

As a result of a complaint received on November 21, 2022, York Region Public Health conducted an inspection at the premise on November 23, 2022. York Region Public Health noted concerns with reprocessing of re-usable non-critical and semi-critical equipment/devices. Operator failed to ensure appropriate disinfectants were being used for reprocessing of semi-critical items. Manufacturer's Instructions for Use were not followed for use of disinfectants. Operator failed to keep records for high-level disinfection. Operator failed to ensure that single-use equipment is discarded after use.
