On location at 62 Bayview Parkway, the site is secured by fencing, the grounds are cleared and prepared for development. Behind the scenes, York Region is working to have the necessary plans in place so the project is ready for development when funding is secured.

York Region is pleased to announce that <u>SvN Architects + Planners</u> has been selected as the architectural firm to lead the design of the new development.

The project team is engaging with the Town of Newmarket, the Community Liaison Committee and close neighbours to refine plans and gather feedback. The focus for 2022 to 2023 is concept development, preparing planning applications and seeking funding.

The new year ahead presents many opportunities to build on the progress made so far.

Emergency and Transitional Housing Developments

In addition to building community housing, York Region is constructing new emergency and transitional housing developments. As winter begins, the need for emergency and transitional housing remains high in our communities, and many individuals and families struggle to secure safe and affordable housing.

To help people keep and find housing, York Region recently opened Passage House, an 18-unit transitional housing building for adult men in the Town of East Gwillimbury.
